We hope this message finds you well as we transition into the winter season. Nursery Fees Increase

We just wanted to make all parents and carers aware that our nursery fees have increased as of 01/12/2024.

We have made the decision to increase our nursery fees due to substantial rises in operational costs since July 2024, including a notable increase in rent for both our sites, alongside the rising costs of essential supplies and utilities. Additionally, the recent increase in the National Minimum Wage has impacted staffing costs, as we remain committed to fairly compensating our dedicated and qualified team. This fee adjustment is necessary to allow us to continue providing exceptional care and education.

As always, we have made every effort to keep this increase to a minimum. The updated fees will be available on our website.
